**REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST**  
**US-Liberia Health Cooperative Agreement: G2G MOU Implementation**

The Government of the Republic of Liberia (GOL) through the Ministry of Health has received grant from the Government and People of the United States of America through a Government to Government (G2G) Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with specific goal and objective of developing a durable and resilient health system in Liberia, that prevents disease, maintains the health of its population, and enables its economy to thrive; while the USG, in the same vein, advances its bilateral relationship with Liberia and support Liberia's actions to prevent the spread of emerging and existing disease threats globally. The MOU commits both governments to the aim of detecting, preventing, and responding to emerging and existing infectious disease threats affecting both Liberia and the United States. Overall, the MoU will ultimately improve the health care delivery system and sponsored program contained in the MoU.

With support provided through the MOU over a period of 5 years (2026-2030) it is envisaged that the fifteen (15) County Health Teams and stakeholders will intervene in the six (6) Areas of Cooperation namely: Surveillance and Outbreak Response, Laboratory Systems, Commodities, Frontline Health Workforce, Data Systems and Strategic Investments. The models for implementation include Hybrid Management and Direct Contracting through the principles of Adaptive Management.

**The provision of Health Services and enhanced System Strengthening interventions will focus on:** Surveillance and Outbreak Response, Laboratory Systems including upgrading laboratories to ISO standards, Procurement and distribution of Commodities, Data Systems including development, upgrading, hosting, and interoperability, improvement in HIV, Malaria, Polio, and Maternal and Newborn health outcomes.

To implement these services, the Ministry of Health (MOH), through its Procurement Unit, now invites interested and qualified international and local non-governmental, Faith-based and Civil Society Organizations with documented evidence of technical and managerial expertise and backgrounds of healthcare systems management in the six (6) Areas of Cooperation in Liberia, the West Africa region or other developing countries, to indicate their interests in support of the implementation of the assignment above.

**The implementation coverage areas are described as follow:**

**1. Surveillance and Disease Outbreak**

**Lot #1:** Central and County Levels (County and District Health Teams, Public Health Facilities, and Communities)

**2. Laboratory Systems**

**Lot #2:** All counties for Clinical Labs

**Lot #3:** Margibi (National Reference Lab), Maryland, and Nimba IDSR Labs

**3. Commodities**

**Lot #4:** All Counties (All health facilities, County and Regional depots)

**4. Data Systems**

**Lot # 5:** All Counties (All public health facilities, DHTs, and CHTs)

**5. Prevention & Clinical Service Delivery (Malaria, HIV, MCH, Immunization)**

**Lot #6:** All counties (All public health facilities and communities)

Note: Interested firms shall indicate their interest (s) in support of an individual lot or two (2) and the entire contents and levels therein. Selection for contract award shall be in accordance with **Quality Cost Based Selection (QCBS) procedures specified in the amended Public Procurement and Concession Act of 2026, of the Republic of Liberia.**

**Minimum Eligibility Criteria: Essential requirements for participation, including:**

- a. Documentary evidence of the firm's Core Business and Legal Registration: Valid business licenses/certificate and registration in relevant country of national or international databases
- b. Experience in health system management as required, interested firms should be registered with PPCC (applicable to domestic firms).
- c. Experience working in Liberia and or countries of similar context
- d. Brief presentation of the Technical and Managerial Organization of the Firm
- e. Financial flexibility to negotiate over-head cost of not more than 15% of contract value
- f. As an International NGO indicate clear collaborative approach working with local NGOs and County Health Team (CHT) at county and district level
- g. Technical Capability: Evidence of similar past projects, organizational charts, and CVs for key personnel Country Manager, Project Manager and senior financial Manager and contact details of each
- h. Authorized certificate to provide health system management services

- i. Financial Standing: Audited financial statements or minimum turnover requirements from recent years (2023, 2024 & 2025).

**Note:** This position is a full time, and the initial period of the contract will be 24 months, subject to negotiation for extension after a year based on good performance.
