- 1. This Invitation for Bids seeks to initiate a solicitation process which will lead to the haring of a firm to supply and deliver Laboratory Supplies in support to the fight against COVID-19 in Liberia.

 - ii. Past performance records-including the names and contact details of at least two (2) clients.
 - iii. Delivery of the Goods required is 7-14 days after receipt of the notice to proceed.
 - iv. Bidders should have completed, within the last five years from the date of submission and receipt of bids, a contract similar to this package; details shall be included
 - v. Documentary evidence of business legitimacy in residence country
 - vi. Valid certificate of tax compliance in your country shall be included and Articles of Incorporation with that of Valid Business Registration Certificate.
- 5. Bidding will be conducted through the International Competitive Bidding (ICB) procedures specified in the Amended and Restated Public Procurement Act of 2010, and are open to all Eligible Bidders.
